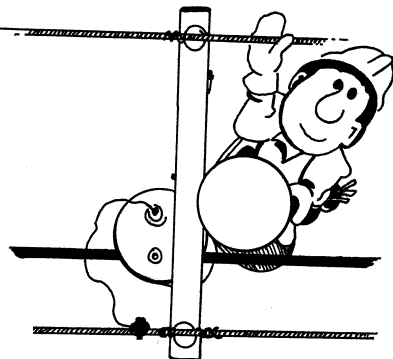


SEEK OUT SAFETY THIS SUMMER



Have some fun as you learn about electric safety. Across, backwards, down and up, find and highlight the 24 word groups in the grid that are in the list in bold. You'll find the answers in Ripley Power and Light's section inside this magazine.

- 1) If you see a **power line** on the ground or hanging loose from a utility **pole**, call **Ripley Power and Light Company**.
- 2) **Electricity** is dangerous. Stay away from equipment and fences marked with **DANGER** signs or **high voltage**.
- 3) Never put **metal** objects in electric **sockets**.
- 4) Do not overload a **circuit**, **outlet** or **extension cord**.
- 5) Do not use **appliances** with a **frayed** cord.
- 6) Use a ground fault circuit interrupter (**GFCI**) for electrical devices used outside to help prevent electric **shock** injuries.
- 7) Keep electrical devices at least 10 feet away from water sources, such as a swimming **pool** or **spa**.
- 8) Never handle **electrical** devices when you are wet or standing in **water**.
- 9) Keep **kites**, **ladders** and **hunting** equipment away from power lines.
- 10) Always **report** an **outage**.
