
## SEEK OUT SAFETY THIS SUMMER

- 1) If you see a **power line** on the ground or hanging loose from a utility pole, call Ripley Power and Light Company.
- 2) **Electricity** is dangerous. Stay away from equipment and fences marked with **DANGER** signs or high voltage.
- 3) Never put **metal** objects in electric sockets.
- 4) Do not overload a circuit, outlet or extension cord.
- 5) Do not use **appliances** with a **frayed** cord.
- 6) Use a ground fault circuit interrupter (GFCI) for electrical devices used outside to help prevent electric **shock** injuries.
- 7) Keep electrical devices at least 10 feet away from water sources, such as a swimming pool or spa.
- 8) Never handle electrical devices when you are wet or standing in water.
- 9) Keep kites, ladders and hunting equipment away from power lines.
- 10) Always report an outage.
